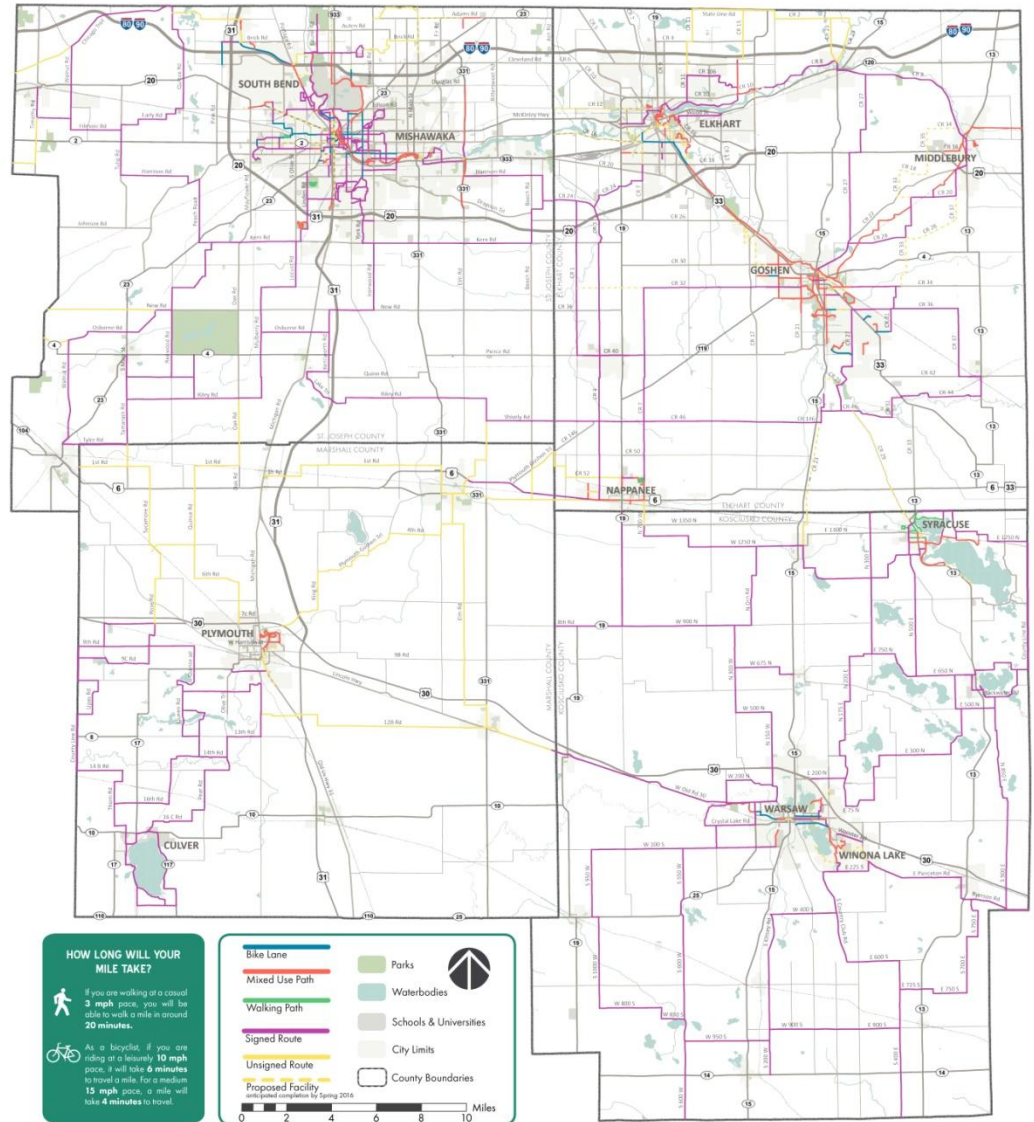
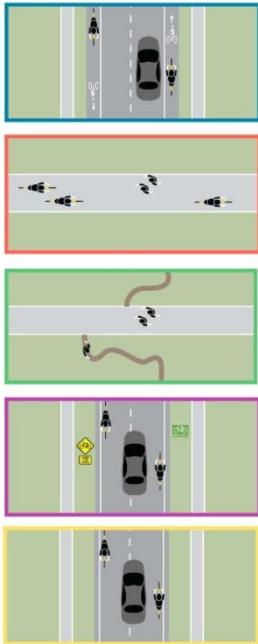

HOW LONG WILL YOUR MILE TAKE?

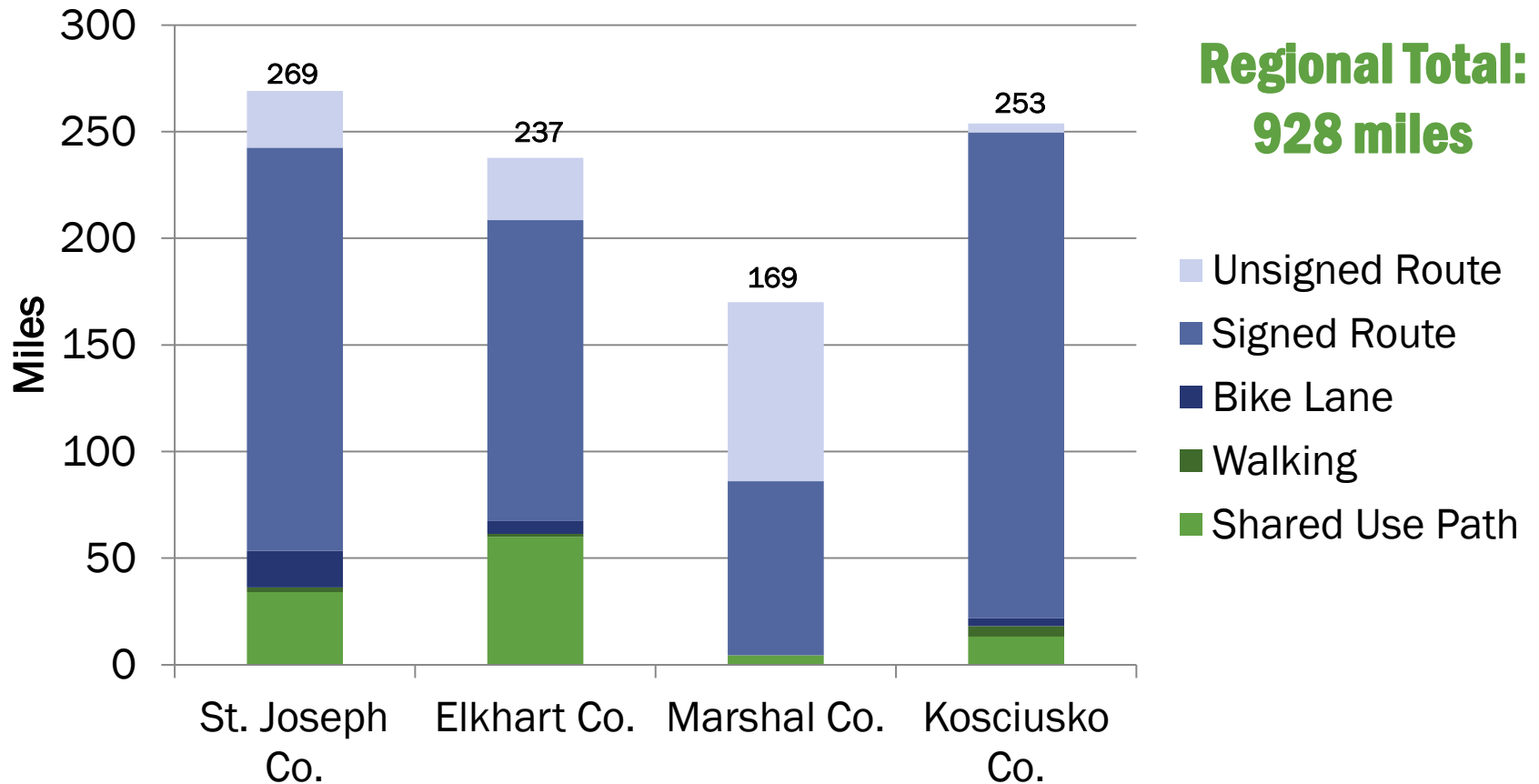
If you are walking at a casual 3 mph pace, you will be able to walk a mile in around 20 minutes.

As a bicyclist, if you are riding at a leisurely 10 mph pace, it will take 6 minutes to travel a mile. For a medium 15 mph pace, a mile will take 4 minutes to travel.

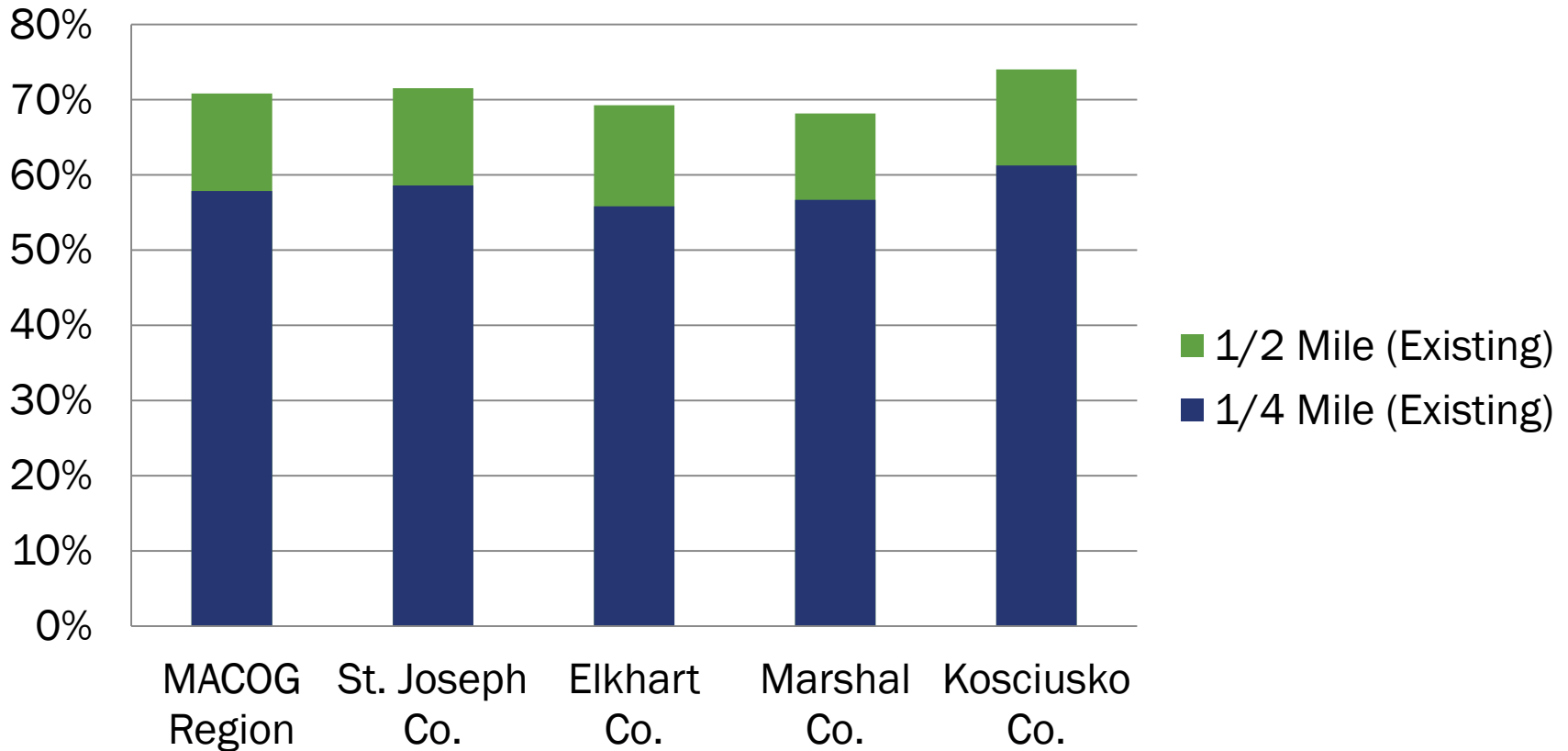

Where We Are: Miles of Facilities

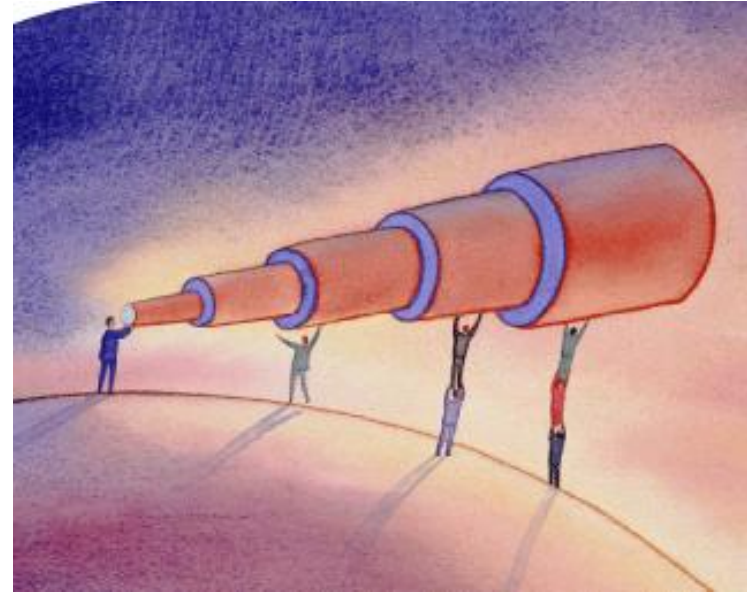


Where We Are: Population near Facilities



Defining a Vision

- » Statement of desired outcomes for the future
- » Intended to be compelling and inspiring
 - » The “hook”
- » Leads to defined goals and objectives

Defining Goals

- » Broad statement describing a desired end state

- » Directly influence performance measurement
- » Differs from objectives
